Cleanliness in Islam

Why Cleanliness Matters

- Cleanliness is an important part of a Muslim's life.
- We should keep our bodies and clothes clean.
- The Prophet taught that cleanliness is half of faith.

Wudu and Salah

- We perform wudu before Salah and before touching the Qur'an.
- We make sure our body and clothes are clean before wudu.
- The Prophet taught that the key to prayer is wudu.

Clean Habits

- Wash regularly and wear clean clothes.
- Come to the masjid wearing clean and nice clothes.
- Cleanliness includes good personal hygiene as well as wudu and ghusl.

Manners of Using the Toilet

Before and While Using the Toilet

- Recite the du'a before entering and enter with the left foot.
- Make sure water/tissue is available and the seat is clean.
- Do not talk, recite Qur'an, make du'a, or mention Allah's name while inside.
- Be careful to keep your body and clothes free from urine.

After Using the Toilet

- Clean the private parts properly, using the left hand for washing.
- Flush and leave the toilet clean for the next person.
- Wash your hands, exit with the right foot, and recite the du'a after leaving.
- Good toilet manners protect cleanliness and help us follow the Sunnah.
