Why Salah Is So Important

Salah in a Muslim's Life

- Salah is the second pillar of Islam and an essential part of a Muslim's daily life.
- The five daily prayers remind us of our relationship with Allah.
- Salah is the key to Paradise and is one of the most important acts of worship.

Salah Wipes Away Sins

- The Prophet (ﷺ) compared the five daily prayers to bathing in a river five times every day.
- Just as no dirt would remain, Allah wipes away sins through the five daily prayers.
- Salah also helps prevent shameful actions and evil deeds.

Salah Determines Our Outcome

- The first deed a servant of Allah will be questioned about on the Day of Judgement is prayer.
- If the prayer is good, the rest of the person's deeds will be good.
- Regular prayer is a promise of Paradise for those who perform it properly at its fixed times.

Never Abandon Salah

A Serious Warning

- The Prophet (ﷺ) warned that abandoning prayer is extremely serious.
- A Muslim should do his or her best to perform Salah on time, at home or elsewhere.
- We should lovingly remind family members to pray and remain patient and respectful.

What We Should Remember

- Pray the five daily prayers consistently and at their proper times.
- Never give up Salah because of laziness or inconvenience.
- Encourage your family to pray and be steadfast yourself.
- Salah strengthens faith, protects us from sin, and prepares us for the Hereafter.
